## What is the PCC?

The **parochial church council (PCC)** is the executive committee of a Church of England and consists of clergy and churchwardens of the parish, together with representatives of the congregation. Every PCC is also a Charity and so its members are also trustees.

## What does the PCC do?

Legally the council is responsible for the financial affairs of the church parish and the maintenance of its assets, such as the church. It also assists the clergy in managing church affairs in the parish, and promoting the mission of the church. The PCC also has a voice in the forms of service used by the church and may make representations on matters affecting the welfare and pastoral care of the parish. Our vision for 2023 is Wider, Deeper, Greener.

## Why might i want to get involved?

Whilst PCC meetings include lots of different things, one of the most exciting things that they do is to help discern and respond to God's call for the church, parish and use of it's resources.

## How do I join?

Elections are held each year at the annual meeting (APCM) and the makeup of a PCC is set out in the Church Representation Rules. To be an elected representative of the congregation, you must be a communicant, be aged 16 or over, and must have been on the church electoral roll for at least 6 months.
