St. Mark's Foodbank

During August & Harvest our charity support was for **Godalming Foodbank**.

It is sad that in such an affluent area as this a foodbank is needed, but St. Mark's run a really good and really needed one. They have around 45 regular clients on a 2 weekly collection basis for a supply of food, cleaning and toiletry products.

They hand out £30 Sainsbury vouchers 3 times a year and more recently have helped with home fuel costs due to funding from Surrey County Council. They also support local organisations such as Loseley Fields and Broadwater Schools, Barnardo Children's Centre, and various Waverley run units, such as family, mental health, children and young people.
