Greetings from the organ bench!

It's a pleasure to introduce myself to you as the new Organist & Choir Director at St Nicholas. You'll find me playing the beautiful Kenneth Jones organ on Sunday mornings at 10.30am & at evensong on 1st Sundays.

My wife, Teresa and I returned to the Guildford area a few years ago to be nearer family. I studied music at the RCM in London and have enjoyed a varied career as a teacher, performer, music theatre vocal coach and MD. I've also had an exciting time as a conductor in a range of chorus-master and choral conducting roles. My previous organ posts include Great Malvern Priory, St Matthew's Anglican Church, Ottawa, Canada, Shrewsbury School and Epsom Parish Church. My teaching career included 12 years as Director of Music at Repton School, Derbyshire and 10 years as Head of Performing Arts at a specialist arts college in Leicester. I still teach piano, singing and A level music at Halliford School in Shepperton and I'm chairman of the Vivace Chorus in Guildford (www,vivacechorus.org).

I'm keen to create opportunities for live music making at St Nicholas, particularly for the weekly Sunday services, but also by providing a musical platform for the wider Compton community throughout the year. I'd like to expand the choir membership to involve more local singers, especially in the unique tradition of choral evensong, and also create opportunities for young people to gain experience in singing, playing the organ and performing in junior workshops and concerts. The church building is an inspiring venue for the arts, so I'm hoping to organise a monthly concert series in the village on a regular basis. In the meantime, as we prepare to mark the seasons of All Saints, Advent and Christmas, the Service in Memory of Loved Ones (Sunday 3 Nov at 3.00pm) has a simple order of hymns and prayers with reflective music for cello and organ by Bach, Mendelssohn and Saint-Saens.
